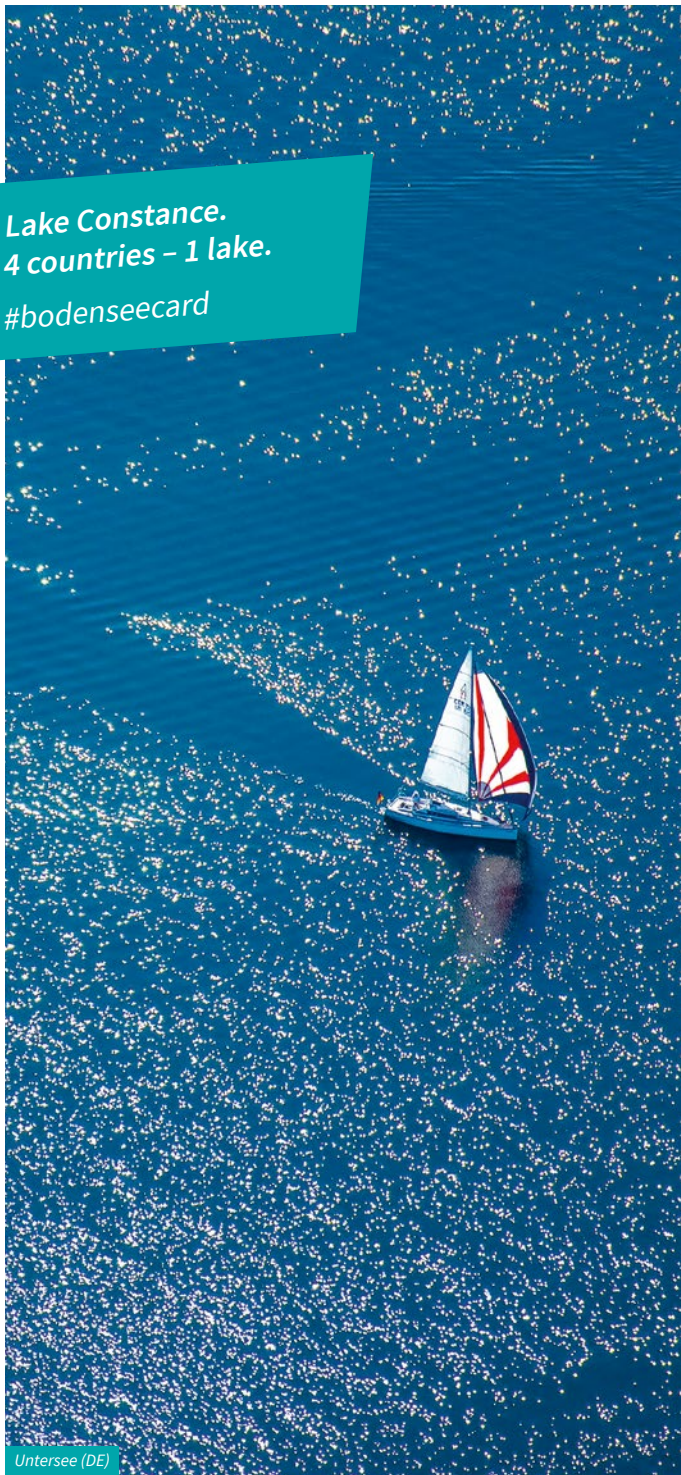

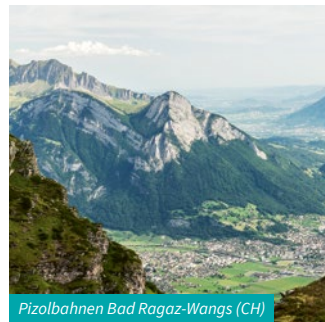

Cardholders can easily discover attractions in Germany, Austria, Switzerland and the Principality of Liechtenstein without incurring any further expenses. Numerous land, mountain and water activities are included – from the Lake Constance classics to new destinations. And the best thing is: you can schedule your Bodensee Card ^{PLUS} activities over twelve months.

How does the Bodensee Card ^{PLUS} work?

The Bodensee Card ^{PLUS} gives you **one-time free admission*** to all the activities listed in this experience guide*! You also get to travel free of charge on all VSU scheduled boat trips on two or four days (with the three- or seven-day card respectively)(can be found on page 14), and enjoy unique discounts that are exclusive to Bodensee Card ^{PLUS} holders (exclusive experiences can be found on page 108). Simply present your Bodensee Card ^{PLUS}.

For how long is the Bodensee Card ^{PLUS} valid?

The Bodensee Card ^{PLUS} is valid for three or seven separate days of your choice. The moment your card is scanned at your destination's ticket office you will have started one of these days (midnight–11:59 pm). Thus, you may choose to use the threeday card on a Monday in April, a Wednesday in July and a Sunday in December during the season. The validity period does not need to be defined beforehand.

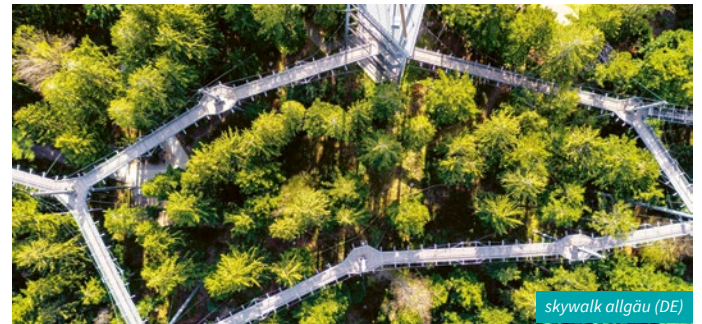

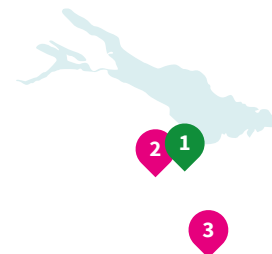

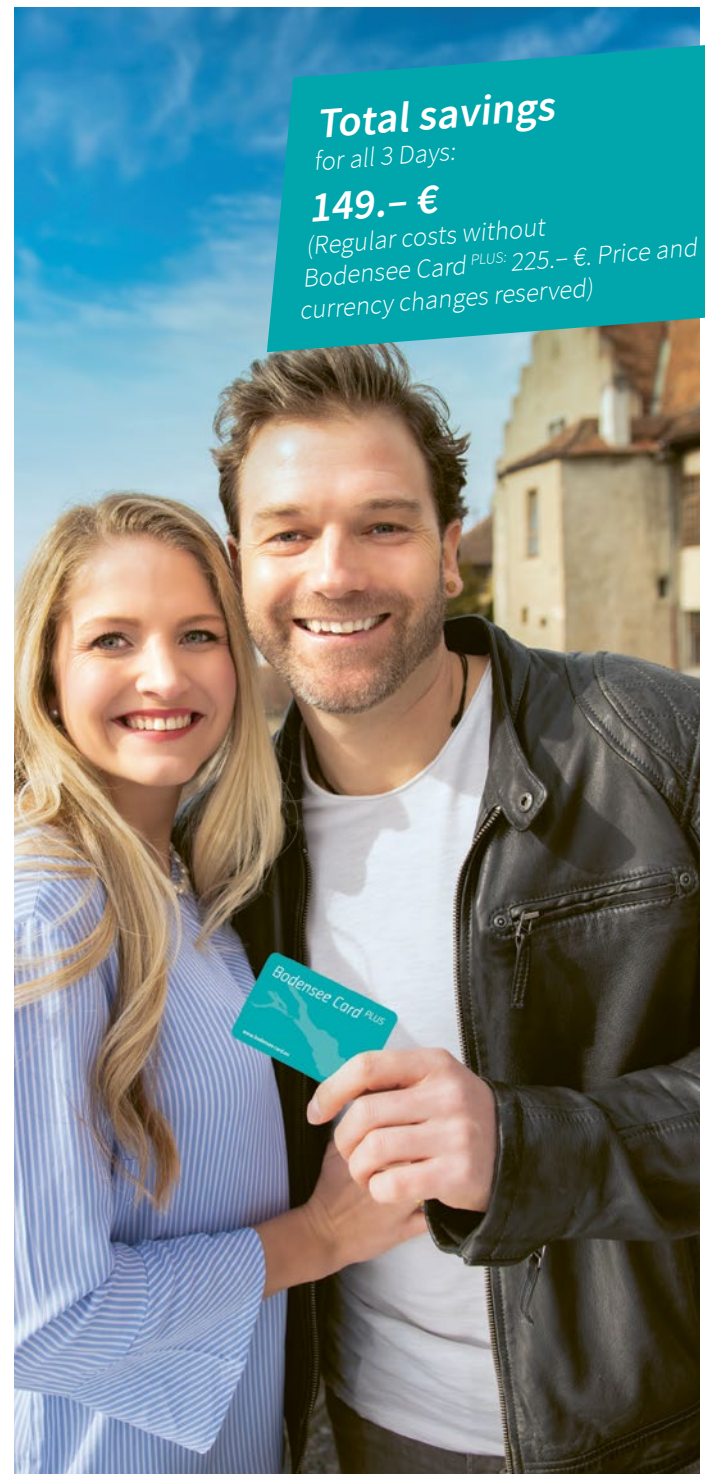

Discover Lake Constance on the White Fleet

A light breeze that strokes your face. The unmistakable smell of the fresh Lake Constance air. A glass of wine by the ship's rail as you look out across the great expanse of the lake: A cruise with the White Fleet means taking a time out. Or how about a refined gala dinner, dancing throughout the night, and a firework display? The fleet of the "Vereinigten Schifffahrtsunternehmen für den Bodensee und Rhein" (VSU) offers numerous opportunities to get away from the daily routine for a while.

The White Fleet is a consortium of Swiss, Austrian and German passenger ship companies that bring guests to beautiful locations with regularly scheduled service from Easter through late fall. The White Fleet sails directly to the front door of many attractions including Zeppelin Museum in Friedrichshafen and SEA LIFE Constance from multiple ports-of-call. It's easy to escape life on land – if only for a few hours with daily departures from the Upper Lake, Lower Lake, Überlinger Lake and Rhine River.

The 3-country Panorama Tour is a great way to explore Germany, Austria, and Switzerland in a day. The Lake Constance bike route is directly linked with White Fleet ports-of-call, making the bike-and-boat combination the easiest way to get around the lake.

Active & Sporty

A boat trip is also perfect for the active and sporty amongst us. The scheduled trips are a perfect addition to many of the hikes and cycle trails. There are wonderful views from the many lovely cycling and hiking trails around Lake Constance. Once back on board, you can then sit back and relax with a well-earned drink on the way back.

- » free travel on the White Fleet on 2 or 4 days (**within** the 3 or 7 days of validity)
- » The car ferry connection Friedrichshafen—Romanshorn is for pedestrians from 2 April up to and including 15 October 2023 free of charge and counts as a shipping day (see previous point). Car drivers pay the cheapest tariff (up to 4 m). Before and after this time, holders of the Bodensee Card ^{PLUS} receive 50% discount on the regular price (more information on page 113).

TIP

A convenient way to reach Bregenz is by boat. From the harbour, the Pfänder cable car valley station is only 8 minutes walking.

There is a play area next to the summit station for families to enjoy. The Alpenwildpark nearby is home to deer, ibex, wild boar, mouflon and groundhogs. Whether you take the gentle 30 minutes stroll through the Alpenwildpark or the more athletic 1.5 hours climb from the valley to the summit, the Pfänder is an excellent starting point for discovering the scenery.

The Rhine Valley viewing terrace on the roof of the summit station is the perfect place to relax, sitting on one of the ergonomic benches and enjoying the panoramic views. The Berghaus Pfänder (beginning of May to end of September) and the Gasthaus Pfänderdohle (end of September to beginning of May) are both tempting spots for a bite to eat while enjoying the views, good snacks and homemade cakes.

Panoramic views over six countries and Lake Constance

Säntis (2,502 m above sea level) is just fascinating. Enjoy the unique panoramic view over six countries, Lake Constance and the foothills of the Alps. The mountain is worth the trip, whatever the weather. At the summit, there are generous sunny terraces and paths, a souvenir shop and the new terrace restaurant in the style of an Alpine chalet. Discover the new interactive exhibitions ‘Säntis – der Wetterberg’ (weather mountain) and ‘Säntis – die Eisswelt’ (a world of ice), ‘Säntis – die Geschichte’ (history) and ‘Säntis – die Geologie’ (geology). Come in, look around and enjoy!

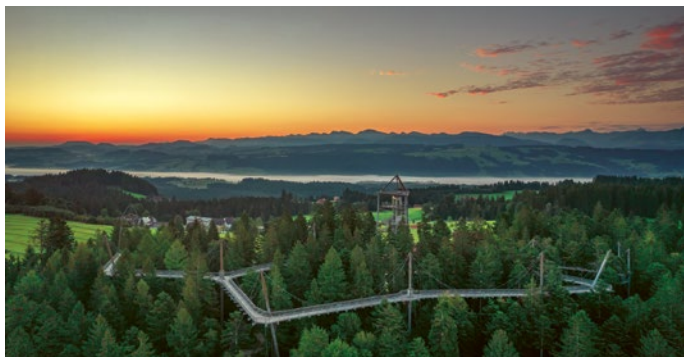

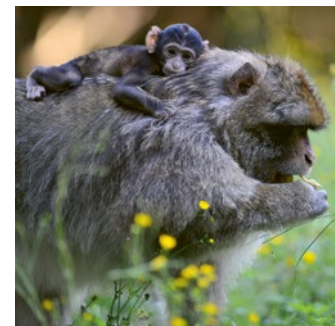

TOP attractions at Lake Constance:

Old Castle in Meersburg



1

1,000 Years of History in these Walls

Cross the heavy drawbridge and walk through the wooden doors to enter the Middle Ages. Allegedly Germany's oldest and continuously inhabited castle, the original fortress in Meersburg traces its origins back to the 7th century Merovingian Dynasty under King Dagobert I. Perfectly preserved, this thick-walled behemoth was never stormed or destroyed by invaders. Visit more than 36 furnished rooms on a self-guided tour, including the knights' hall, the great hall, castle kitchen, well-water chamber and guardsmen walkways along the castle wall. Imagine how medieval justice was served in the torture chamber at the base of Dagobert's Tower and deep inside the castle dungeon.

The tour also includes furnished rooms where famous German poetess Annette von Droste-Hülshoff lived intermittently, drawing inspiration from the lake and castle environs. Her bust figure stands at the main gate and although unknown to most foreigners, she wrote prolifically at Meersburg Castle until her death in 1848.

The castle's quaint café with a panoramic terrace and adjoining rooms affording magnificent lake views are just the thing for a relaxing break.

Salem Monastery and Palace

The Cistercian legacy

The former Cistercian abbey and present-day Salem Palace is located in the midst of extensive parks and gardens.

The monastery, founded in 1134, became soon an imperial abbey and quickly developed into one of the most important in southern Germany.

Salem experienced a second heyday in the baroque period, as evidenced by the splendidly furnished abbey, which is still the family seat of the margraves of Baden (since 1802). The Monastery Museum Salem in the prelatore, a branch museum of the Badisches Landesmuseum in Karlsruhe, presents Masterpieces of the imperial abbey. The Salem Fire Brigade Museum near Sennhof exhibits a unique collection of fire pumps and devices that includes real rarities: hand fire pumps, steam fire engines and even motorised pumps. Salem's treasures at a glance: the gothic cathedral with its alabaster interior, Monastery Museum, extensive palace complex with parks and an adventure playground, Fire Brigade Museum, historical wine press, baroque stables, artisan shops, wine shop and restaurant. All museums and exhibitions are included in the admission fee. Guided tours can be booked.

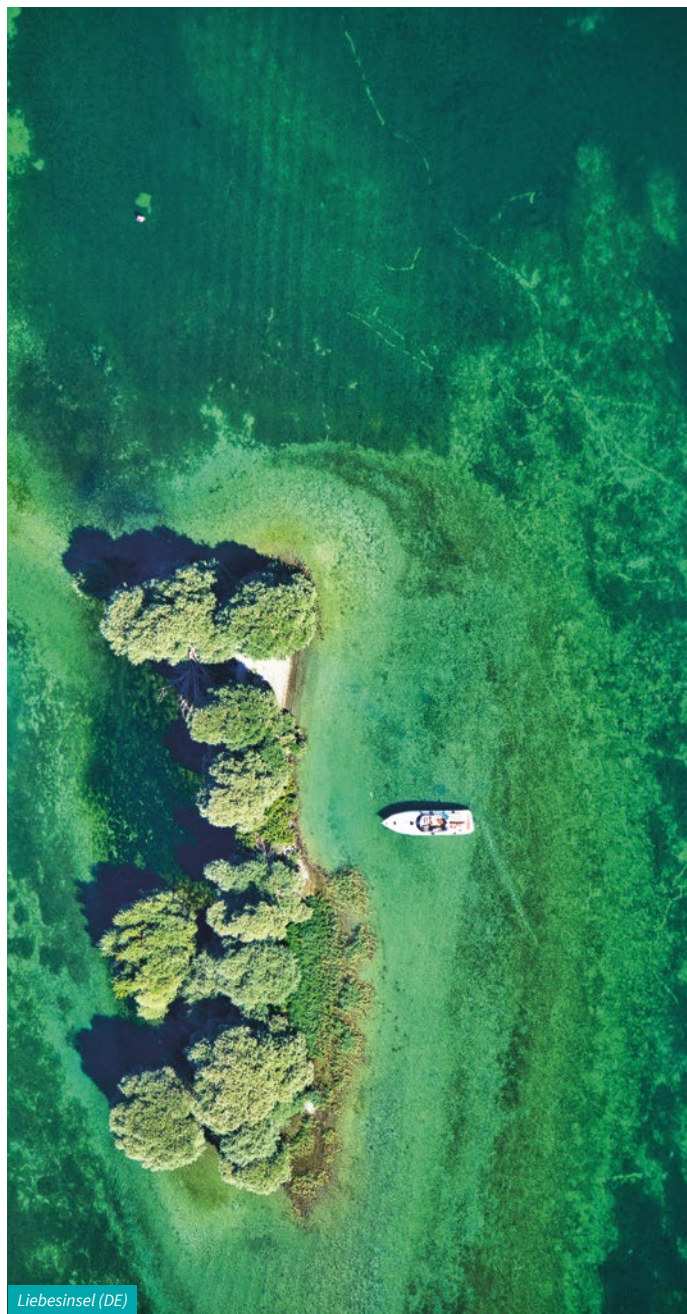

World heritage pile dwellings

Established in 1922, the Pile Dwelling Museum brings the fascinating sunken 'Prehistoric Pile Dwellings around the Alps' UNESCO World Heritage Site to life. It is one of the most popular leisure destinations on Lake Constance and one of the largest archaeological open-air museums in Europe, comprising 23 reconstructions of houses from the Stone Age and the Bronze Age. This spectacular location on Lake Constance gives visitors insight into how people lived 6,000 and 3,000 years ago respectively. The museum's main attraction is the faithfully reproduced pile dwellings, where the museum staff will inform you. The first two dwellings to be built on this site were only recently reopened. They house a temporary exhibition about the establishment of the museum. In the holiday seasons, you can take the Stone Age tour, a voyage of discovery where experimental archaeologists demonstrate the technical expertise that prehistoric people already possessed. A temporary exhibition displays original artefacts from the World Heritage Site, including 5,000-year-old apples, Stone Age chewing gum, mysterious mythical creatures and period jewellery. The Pile Dwelling Museum has received multiple awards for being family-friendly and accessible to disabled people, among them the 'Inklusion Plus Award'.

General terms and conditions and terms of use for Bodensee Card^{PLUS} services

Dear Guest, The special services and benefits available through the Bodensee Card^{PLUS} are provided to you by the relevant service partners to make your trip to Lake Constance an unforgettable experience. Clear agreement on the mutual rights and obligations, which are defined in the following terms of use, shall help contribute to this. Please read these terms of use carefully prior to using the card and the associated services.

1. Parties' position; entering into the agreement

1.1 Subject to the purchase of a Bodensee Card^{PLUS}, **Internationale Bodensee Tourismus GmbH (hereinafter 'IBT')** shall undertake to provide the cardholder with the services and benefits of the respective service providers as specified in the service descriptions in the 'Lake Constance Experience Guide' brochure. Insofar as the cardholder purchases the Bodensee Card^{PLUS} from a service provider, a local tourist office or another point of sale, the latter party shall act solely as an agent of IBT in entering into the agreement and shall hence constitute neither a contractual partner of the cardholder nor a contractual agent.

1.2 Upon or immediately after entering into the agreement, the cardholder shall receive a copy of the confirmation of the agreement in a format that is suitable for long-term storage. The cardholder shall receive a printed copy of the confirmation of the agreement if the agreement is entered into in the simultaneous physical presence of both parties to the agreement or off-premises (Section 312b of the German Civil Code [BGB]). In the latter case, another format that is suitable for long-term storage may also be used with the cardholder's consent.

1.3 The services specified in the Lake Constance Experience Guide shall be provided to the cardholder exclusively by the respective service providers listed in the Lake Constance Experience Guide. By purchasing the Bodensee Card^{PLUS}, the cardholder shall be entitled to the services and benefits provided by the respective service providers to the extent of the service descriptions of the services and benefits in the Lake Constance Experience Guide.

1.4 Solely the cardholder or the accompanying persons specified in accordance with the service description shall be entitled to use the card.

1.5 In addition to these terms of use, the service relationship between the cardholder and the service provider shall also be subject to the terms and conditions of the respective service provider insofar as these have become effective terms of the agreement pursuant to legal provisions and do not conflict with these terms of use.

2. Services

2.1 The nature, extent, prices and conditions of the services that the cardholder is entitled to shall be exclusively based on the respective service description in the Lake Constance Experience Guide valid at the time of purchase of the Bodensee Card^{PLUS} and issued along with the card to the cardholder.

2.2 The service partners shall only be obligated to provide services in accordance with their general terms and conditions, that is, with regard to the advertised times for the provision of the service, opening hours and general conditions for the provision of the service (for example, weather conditions) in particular.

2.3 The working hours of some service providers, primarily due to weather and seasonal conditions, shall not extend to the entire period of validity of the Bodensee Card^{PLUS}. In this respect, the extent of the service shall be limited to the respective service partner's current and usual working hours.

2.4 Ferry services shall be based on scheduled routes according to timetable and not on special events or special services.

2.5 Tourist offices, system operators or other third parties shall not be entitled to give guarantees, enter into agreements or provide information that differs from or contradicts the advertised services of the service partner.

2.6 Insofar as the services that are available due to the purchase of the card are described in other promotional materials (lodging directories, brochures, catalogues, websites) in a manner that differs from the respective valid service description in the Lake Constance Experience Guide, the respective service description for the use of the card shall apply exclusively to the use of these services by the cardholder. This shall apply in particular insofar as the service description for the use of the card differs from other such service descriptions. Claims against IBT or the respective service providers shall not be justified by such promotional materials.

3. Service providers' right to withhold provision of the service

3.1 The Bodensee Card^{PLUS} shall entitle the cardholder to the services specified in the service description in the Lake Constance Experience Guide only in accordance with the legal provisions and the general availability of the services.

3.2 Service providers shall have the general legal right to withhold provision of the service. In particular, they shall be entitled to withhold provision of the service in specific cases if there are objective reasons for not providing the service. This shall apply in particular insofar as the cardholder or accompanying persons entitled to use the services do not fulfil the necessary conditions for the use of the services (such as equipment, health, check-in times).

4. Withdrawal by the cardholder; obligations of the cardholder

4.1 The guest may withdraw informally from the agreement entered into with IBT at any time until the start of the trip. The effective date shall be the date that IBT receives the notification of withdrawal.

4.2 Should the cardholder withdraw from the agreement, IBT shall cease to be entitled to the agreed purchase price regarding the Bodensee Card^{PLUS}. However, IBT may demand reasonable compensation, the amount of which shall be based on the purchase price less the value of the saved expenditures of IBT and less what IBT shall acquire through other use of the contractual services.

4.3 IBT may not demand compensation in the event of unavoidable, exceptional circumstances at the destination or in its immediate vicinity that significantly affect use of the Bodensee Card^{PLUS}. Circumstances shall be unavoidable and exceptional if they are not under the control of the party that induces them, and their consequences would have also been unavoidable had all reasonable precautions been taken.

5. Validity of the Bodensee Card^{PLUS}

5.1 The validity of the Bodensee Card^{PLUS} shall depend on the selected card type for the period in which the card services may be used and on the respective seasonal edition of the card (summer or winter edition) for the season in which it may be used. In this respect, the limitations specified in the Lake Constance Experience Guide shall apply.

5.2 The card shall only be valid for the season for which it has been purchased and consequently shall not be transferable to the next season.

5.3 In the event of non-use of the card, a refund or reduction of the card fee shall be excluded, unless the non-use shall be due, in full or in part, to the culpable breach of the contractual obligations by IBT.

6. Obligations and liability of the cardholder

6.1 The Bodensee Card^{PLUS} shall not be transferable and shall only be valid in conjunction with valid photo identification. It may only be used by the person specified on the card.

6.2 The cardholder shall be obligated to present the original Bodensee Card^{PLUS} and submit it to the service provider for electronic or visual inspection prior to entering into the respective individual agreement for use of the service.

6.3 The cardholder shall be obligated to present valid photo identification upon request. Should the cardholder not be able to do so, the service provider may withhold provision of the service.

6.4 In the case of age-related services and benefits for the cardholder or their entitled relatives, the service provider may request appropriate proof of age.

6.5 In the event of theft or loss of the Bodensee Card^{PLUS}, the cardholder shall be obligated to immediately report this incident on +49 (0)7531 909499 and shall not be entitled to the issue of a new card free of charge.

6.6 The cardholder shall be liable to IBT and the service providers for damages arising from misuse of the Bodensee Card^{PLUS} by the cardholder in full or in part.

6.7 The cardholder shall be obligated to immediately notify IBT of any defect that may occur. Should the cardholder fail to immediately notify IBT of the defect, the cardholder's entitlement to a reduction of the card fee in accordance with Section 651 of the BGB and to damages in accordance with Section 651n of the BGB shall lapse, unless the failure to notify IBT of the defect shall be through no fault of the guest.

7. Liability of IBT

7.1 The contractual liability of IBT for damage that does not constitute physical injury shall be limited to three times the purchase price of the Bodensee Card^{PLUS} insofar as the damage to the cardholder has not been intentional or due to negligence.

7.2 Should international agreements or legal provisions based on such agreements, according to which a claim for damages against the service provider shall arise or be asserted only in certain conditions or within certain limitations, or shall be excluded in certain conditions, apply to a service of the service provider, IBT may also refer this to the cardholder.

8. Limitation period of claims

8.1 The limitation period for contractual claims by the cardholder shall be two years. The limitation period shall commence on the day that the cardholder's Bodensee Card^{PLUS} becomes invalid.

9. Data Protection

9.1 IBT shall collect, process and store all personal data provided by the cardholder exclusively in accordance with the provisions of German data protection law.

9.2 The use of the cardholder's personal data shall be required to process the agreement entered into with the cardholder. Any other use shall require the cardholder's express consent. 10. Prices; payment terms

10.3 Customers having a domicile outside Germany may pay with Visa, MasterCard, PayPal or Sofortüberweisung. In the case of international payments, any fees incurred shall be borne by the customer.

10.4 The customer shall only have set-off rights if their counterclaims are legally established, undisputed or recognised by IBT in writing. The customer shall only be entitled to exercise a right of retention insofar as their counterclaim is based on the same contractual relationship.

11. Applicable law and place of jurisdiction

In addition, the company Internationale Bodensee Tourismus GmbH has the legally required insurance for the repayment of your payments and, if transport is included in the package tour, for securing your return transport in the event of insolvency.

The most important rights in accordance with Directive (EU) 2015/2302

- Travellers shall receive all essential information about the package tour prior to entering into the package tour agreement.
- At least one contractor shall always be liable for the proper provision of all travel services included in the agreement.

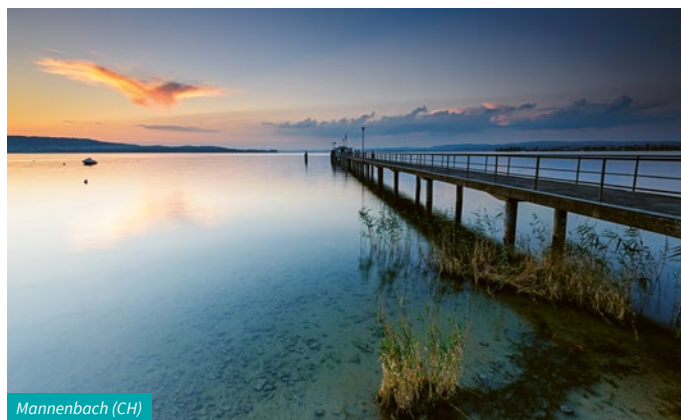

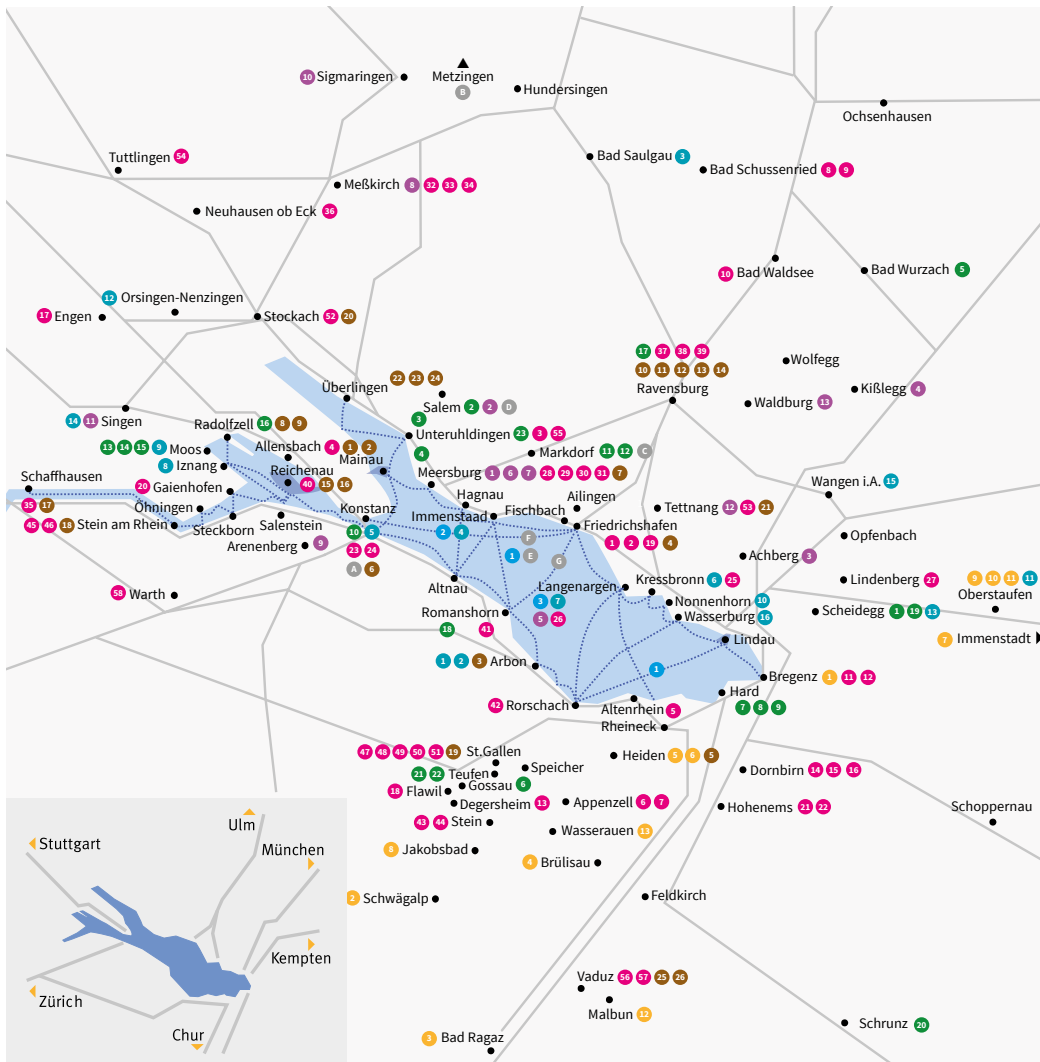
