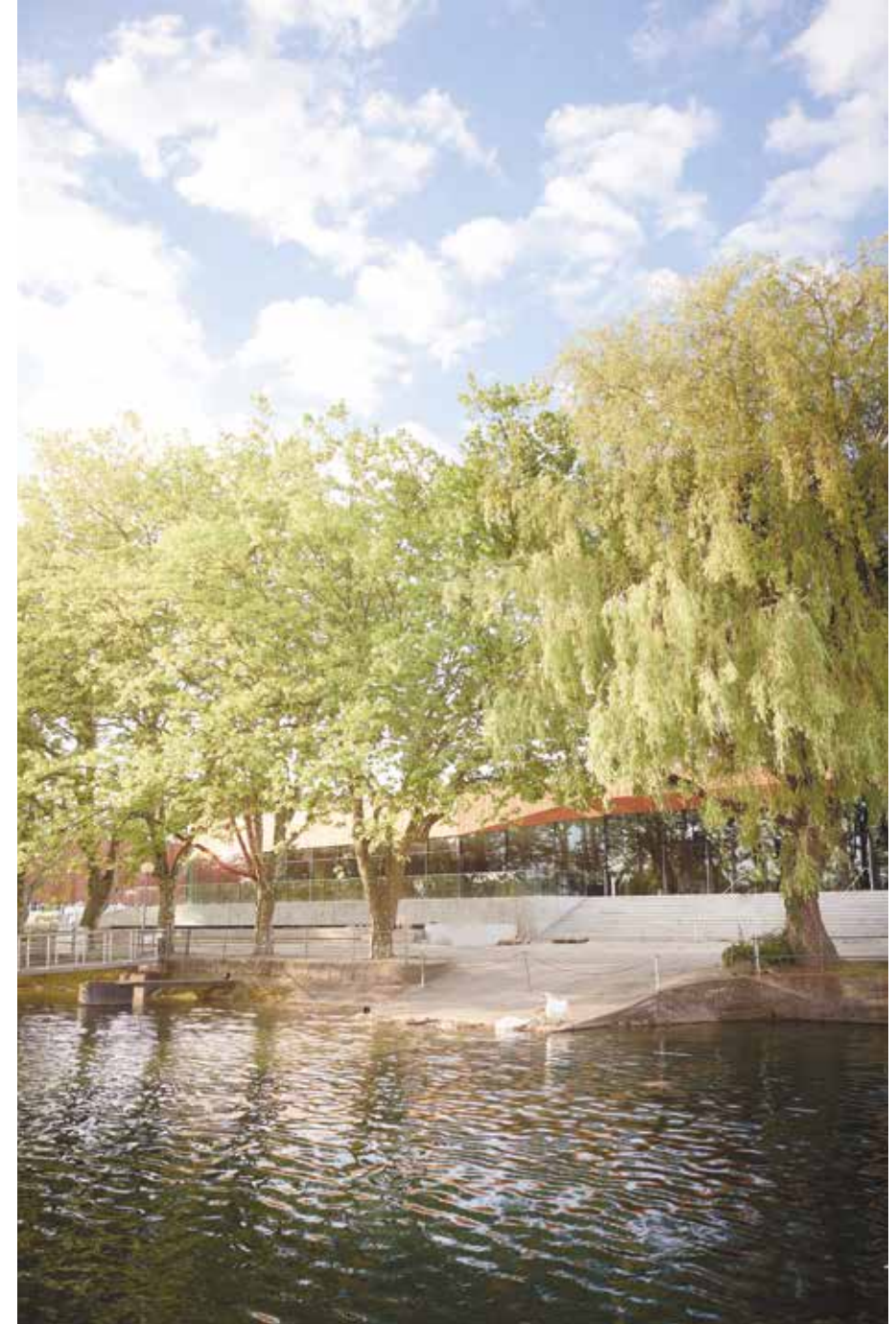

Here, you meet directly on the waterside

Bordered on one side by Lake Constance and on the other by the famous old town, Inselhalle Lindau has always been an attractive platform for events, conferences and conventions.

Events of the highest calibre include Nobel laureate meetings, where the best researchers in their field congregate annually with approximately 600 young scientists to network and engage with each other, and also psychotherapy weeks are held, which boast 4,000 participants. The Inselhalle now stands out from the crowd with its fresh new look.

One hall – 46 options for space

The large auditorium continues to be the main feature of the new Inselhalle. The space has been renovated according to plans by the renowned architectural practice Auer Weber and it now appears more elegant than ever before. Superb acoustics and capacity for more than 1,100 guests make it ideal for plenary sessions during conferences or for concerts. It can be divided into three smaller halls. Ten new conference rooms on the ground floor and two at the basement level are grouped around that central space.

The Clou: due to its modular design, the new Inselhalle Lindau offers 46 room options for events of all kinds and sizes, from galas and workshops, to seminars and get-togethers in our light-filled Main Foyer, for example, which at 1,000 m², has been extended to more than three times its previous size.



Organic catering

Culinary wishes will not be neglected either at the new Inselhalle: delegates can enjoy their coffee break in the lake foyer overlooking the nearby wharf. At our lake restaurant, DECK¹², Andreas Birngruber and his team from Chef Partie look forward to your visit. Both in restaurants and event catering, the Austrian caterer stays true to his philosophy which can be seen in action at events such as the Tollwood Festival in Munich, Salzburg Airport or the Architecture Museum in Vienna: you can expect sustainability, regionality, and 100% organic food.

Full service on your doorstep

Likewise, you can rely on the professionalism of our team when it comes to managing your event: From event planning and hotel booking through to catering and accompanying fringe programmes, we are happy to support you with a comprehensive service, all under one roof. After all, the new Lindau Inselhalle can be found right on your doorstep: a car park with 400 parking spaces is located directly opposite the centre and together with Inselhalle it surrounds the new Therese-von-Bayern square. It too is available to you upon request for exhibitions or for use as

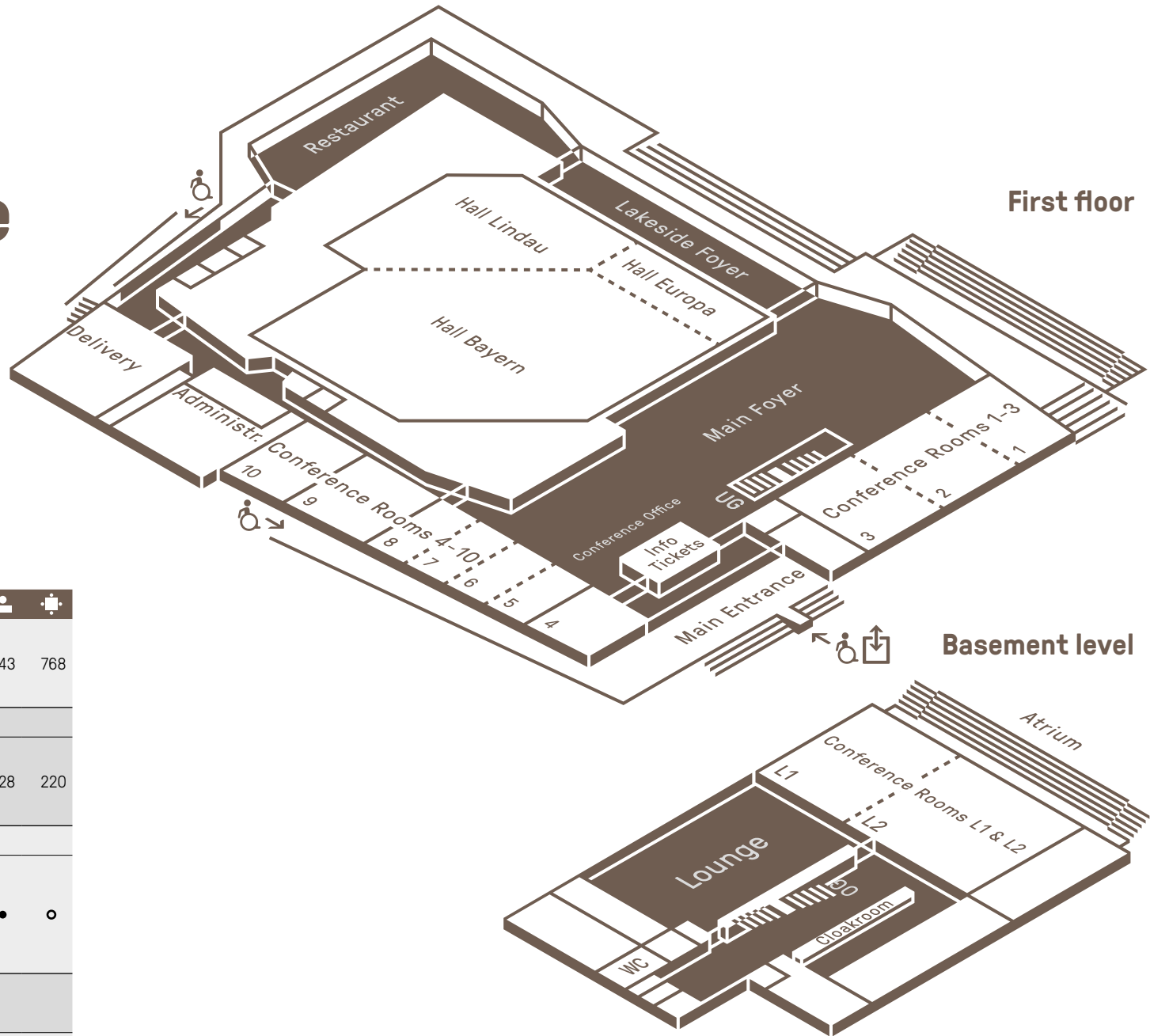
an event space. No less than three regional airports are located within 45 minutes travel time and the island's railway station is just a couple of minutes' walk away.

Event space at the new Inselhalle Lindau

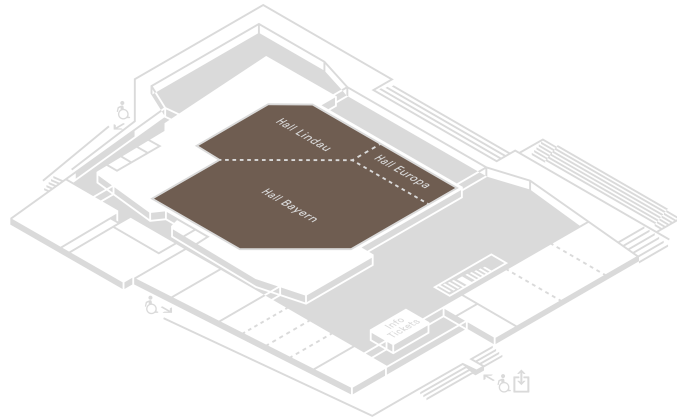

Large Auditorium



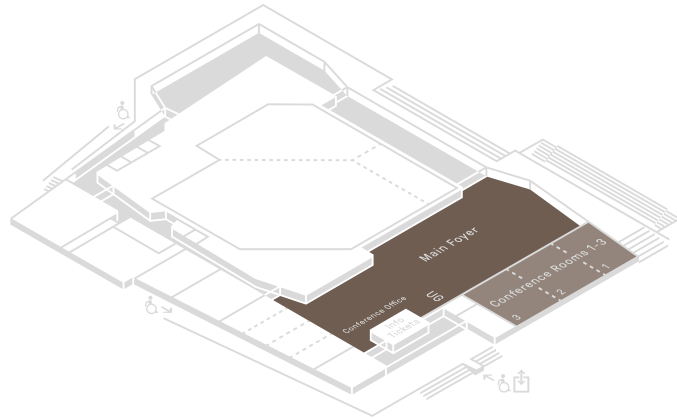

The large auditorium continues to be at the heart of our Inselhalle complex. It can be arranged into three combinations of suites, each featuring the finest quality oak. Its formal atmosphere makes the large

auditorium the perfect location for plenary sessions of more than 1,100 delegates, for larger banquets or even for exhibitions. Our impressive acoustics have already made their mark on concerts.



Main Foyer



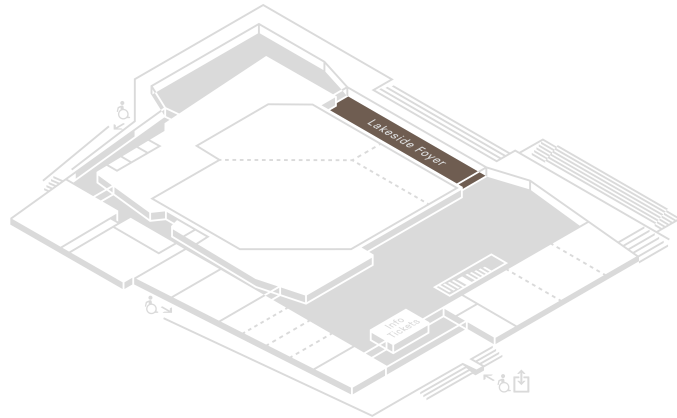

The spacious, light-filled main foyer is the central reception and entrance area. Access is via Therese-von-Bayern square. From the foyer, you have easy access to all function rooms, including the conference rooms. The foyer may also be used for catering and serves as an informal meeting

place during breaks. It is also ideal for exhibitions. When combined with the Conference Room 1-3, it has a surface of more than 1,280 m² (net surface area: 483 m²). The main functions office is also located in the foyer.



Lakeside Foyer



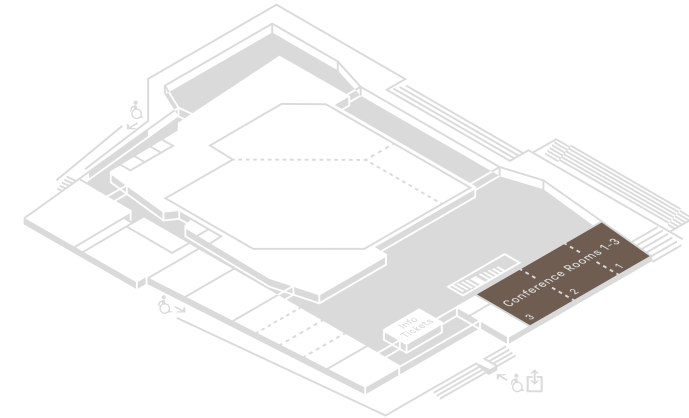

The large 193 m² Lakeside Foyer is located on the north side of the complex. It is adjacent to both the conference and the function rooms, and the restaurant. Through the glass facade, you may look directly onto

the lake. Thanks to open patio doors, the water can be brought that bit closer to you during warm weather. A relaxing atmosphere for receptions or aperitifs is guaranteed at the Lakeside Foyer.

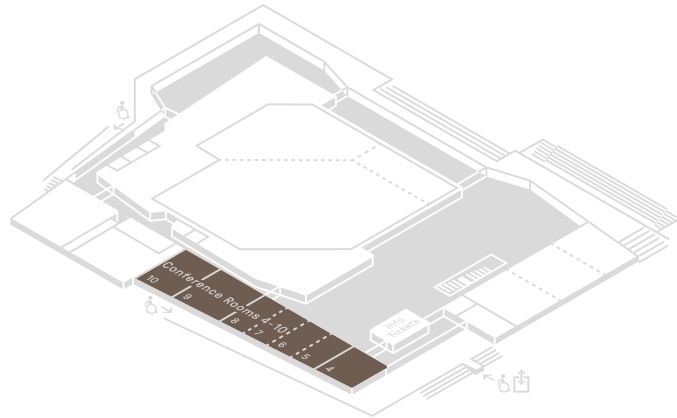

The three conference rooms on the east side of the building have been designed to face the Therese-von-Bayern square and the lakeside. They are flexible and can be combined into different rooms, offering

space for up to 312 delegates. As you would expect, the rooms have been fitted with the most modern equipment in conference technology, ideal for talks and workshops.

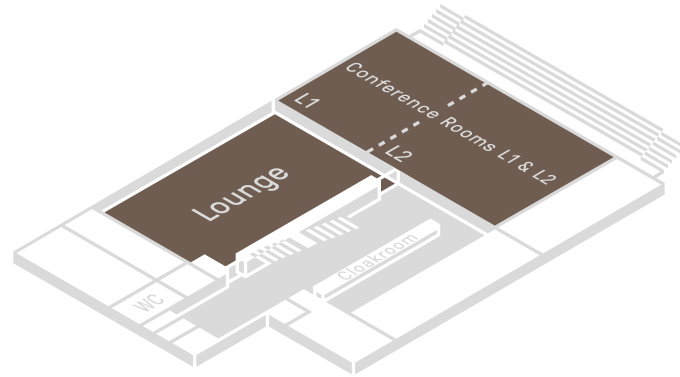

A further seven conference rooms of assorted sizes are available on the south side of the complex. Four of those can be combined through flexible moveable walls, which can be tailored to your needs. Due to the most modern conference technology,

premium floor cover and the availability of full blackout equipment, these spaces offer the perfect setting for meetings and workshops. Additionally, rooms 9 and 10 offer acoustic separation, making them ideal for confidential meetings.



Lounge Area – Basement Level



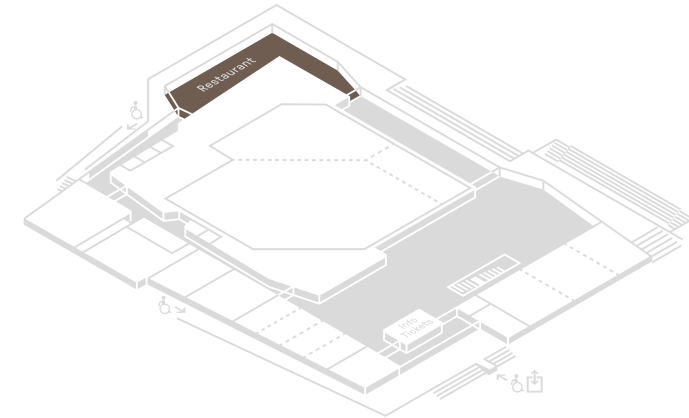

You may access the basement level via the large stairs in the main foyer. It includes a lounge area and two further conference rooms boasting natural daylight. The green atrium connects the lounge to

the waterfront promenade via the stairs. The total surface area is approximately 630 m² maximum. It results in a space which can accommodate more than 590 people.

The DECK¹² lake restaurant can seat approx. 120 indoors and 130 in its outdoor area. It is directly connected to the conference and event area via the Lakeside Foyer.

The restaurant is accessible to the public via a separate entrance. It also takes private bookings for parties or conventions.





Lindau Island has more than 20 hotels and each can be reached within no more than an eight-minute walk. It is a 30-minute trip on the town bus, which connects the island to most of the hotels located further afield.

Whether for 20 or 2,000 delegates: due to 46 different spaces, the new Inselhalle is suitable for any bespoke event.

The electrification of the Memmingen-Lindau rail line is expected to be finished by December 2020, as is the case with the construction of the new Lindau-Reutin railway station. The journey to Zurich and Munich will then be shortened to just under two hours. The train to Stuttgart will also travel much faster due to the electrification of the south line, which will begin in 2021.



Seven airports are located within a two-hour drive, including international hubs such as Munich, Zurich and Stuttgart. A trip to Altenrhein, Friedrichshafen or Memmingen airport is no more than 45 minutes.

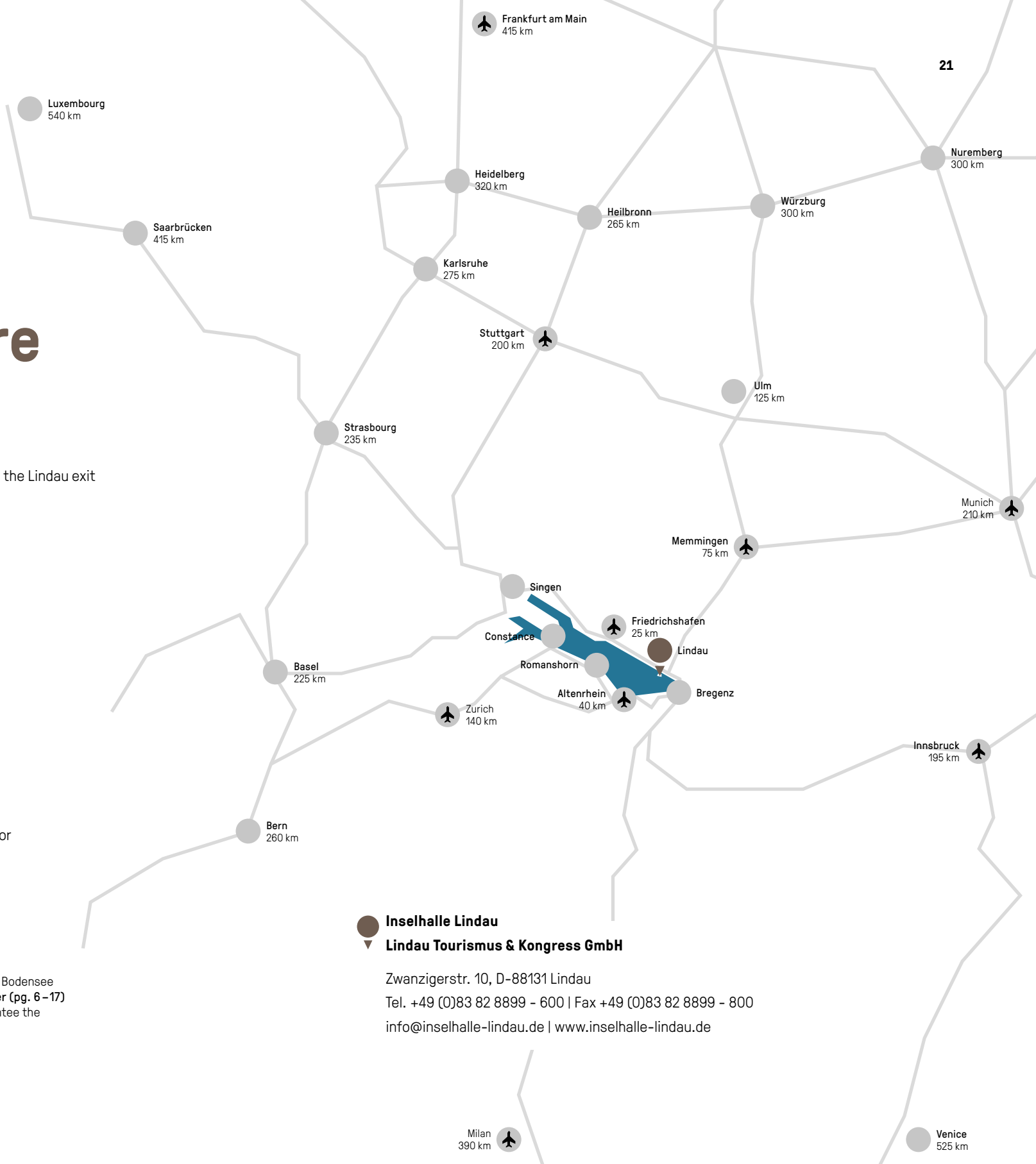
